RE: Declaration of the Distribution of Funds from the “CARE Act” as Emergency Financial Aid for Students the United States Government recently approved the act: “Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES) with the objective of promoting the economy. The act provides grants to educational institutions to be distributed among their students.

As part of the requirements to request these funds, Colegio Técnico de Electricidad Galloza, Inc., signed and returned to the Federal Department of Education a certification and agreement form where we guarantee that at least 50% of the funds received will be disbursed to students.

Colegio Técnico de Electricidad Galloza, Inc. received the amount of \$ 42,670.00 (all funds allocated) 50% to distribute to students was \$ 21,335.00 of which \$14,200.00 have already been distributed. Fourteen (14) students were identified as eligible. \* Eligibility was determined as set forth in Section 484 of the Higher Education Act (HEA).

The total enrollment was eighteen (18) students, fourteen (14) of these were eligible under Section 18004 (a) (1) of the CARES Act. They were disbursed by check on July 28, 2020. Students with dependents were assigned \$ 1,200.00 and without dependents \$ 1,000.00.

The student was oriented about the requirement of the Federal Department of Education regarding the expense of the incentive, which is directed to the fact that students can cover the costs of materials, equipment, technology to be able to continue their classes, food, medical expenses, care of children, housing and other extra expenses in the middle of the emergency that we are experiencing.
